Miraka is the first Maori owned and managed dairy factory.

Situated at Mokai, 30km northwest of Taupo.

Miraka is the result of Maori land owner industry frustration leading to a decision to **take control of their farming futures** by manufacturing their own product and selling directly to a global market.





Established in 2009. Starting production in August 2011.

Miraka is owned by a group of Maori trusts and incorporations:

- Tuaropaki Kaitaki Ltd
- Wairarapa Moana Incorporation,
- Waipapa 9 Trust
- Hauhungaroa Partnership
- Tauhara Moana Trust and
- Pouakani Trust.

The factory produces

- whole and skim milk powder as highquality ingredients;
- various individual consumer powder packs under a high-value brand; Taupo Pure and Whaiora
- UHT milk dedicated to 250 ml Tetra Pak bricks available in:
 - Full Cream
 - Trim Milk
 - High Protein
- Frozen Milk Concentrate





- Miraka milk comes from 107 farms
- All within 85km of our dairy processing plant.
- Total of 70,000 cows
- Total farming area of ~27,000 Ha

Established in 2015 to produce first class milk with the lowest environmental impacts and greatest farming efficiencies.

Works closely with farmers to achieve practices that set a high standard of quality and sustainability.

Each year these standards evolve and expand e.g. biosecurity and create a 'new normal'

To supply milk to Miraka farmers must participate in Te Ara Miraka.



The programme establishes a long-term commitment to:

- Care for the land (Taiao)
- Achieve profitability (Taurikura)
- Grow and support staff (Tangata)
- Produce quality milk (Miraka)
- Maintain healthy and happy animals (Kau)

Is a standards based programme that prescribes best practice.

Farms meeting Te Ara Miraka standards stand to gain an additional 20 cents per kilogram of milk solids - on top of the Miraka milk price.



Te Ara Miraka has evolved to provide a relationship platform for important conversations:

- 100 years, 100 farms
- Legacy farming
- Practice change
- Leadership

Our new norm is building attunement and alignment with the "matauranga Miraka" but is not the end note - it's the opening stanza.

Shifts Te Ara Miraka away from standards, compliance and monitoring - encourage not enforce, admire not admonish

Lifts Te Ara Miraka to Farmer-led vision, empowerment, energy and innovation.



Belly-based farming will allow farmers to intuit and start to connect the dots between climate change, essential freshwater, biodiversity and te mana o te taiao.

It allows them to design and define for themselves how to 'Fit' for a better World.

At Miraka we do not want government to define or prescribe how our farmers should 'fit' according to policy boxes.

We think that is a our and our farmer's role.

Nor do we believe waiting (perhaps in vain) for a vaccine or inhibitor to 'save' the industry.

We prefer to act now and to be fit and ready for whatever the future holds for us.
